### Putting the learner front and centre.

# Delivery

We come to you but can also work from select locations throughout the country if required. Booked for groups of a min 8 participants, 2 hour sessions x 12 at a time that works for your organisation.

#### Training cost

Core Programme (24 hours): \$16,000 plus GST delivered at your site for a group of upto 8 participants. Additional learners can be added for \$1k plus GST per learner.

Extended programme (48 hours delivered): \$28,000 for a group of upto 8. Additional learners can be added for \$1.5k plus GST per learner.


Investment includes design, delivery and learner resources.
